JUSTIN CARTER from PHI KAPPA SIGMA introduced the following proposition
before the delegation

PROPOSITION

The IFC Constitution currently allows the President to appoint Judicial Board members. Traditionally, and within the Judicial Board By-Laws, the IFC Legislative Board also serves as the Judicial Board. To solidify the IFC's position on this issue, this proposition omits the president's power to "appoint" Judicial Board members.
